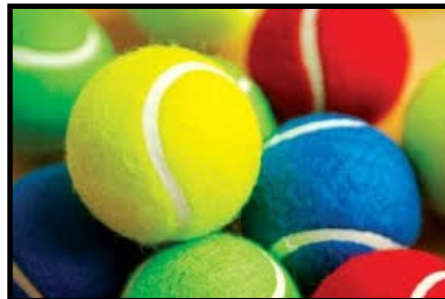


Tennis Squirts- Ages 3-5
