Where: Trees will be planted, and benches installed within approved Readington Township parks and trails. You may request a preferred location where you would like your tree or bench placed, however the exact location is at the discretion of the Township.

When: *Trees* will be planted in November. Trees must be ordered by September 1st for November planting. You will receive a notification letter with the date of planting so you may be present if you wish. *Benches* will be installed year-round weather permitting. Order time is approximately 8 weeks. You will be notified of its location so that you may enjoy it after it has been installed.

What: A plaque, located at the Municipal Building, displays the names of all individuals/organizations for which trees have been planted, including the year of planting. An engraved plaque is installed on each bench.
