



Readington Girls Travel Softball 2026-2027

- We are forming teams in the **10U and 12U** age brackets who qualify through evaluations. Eligibility is determined by the player's age as of August 31, 2026. As a tool, here is the link to the USA Softball Age Calculator (the season is 2027): [AGE CALCULATOR](#)
- The 10U/12U team(s) will have one practice session and one game per week.
- The team(s) will play in the Parkway League in the Fall. Information to follow once the teams are formed.
- Fees include league fees and equipment.
- Parents will pay individually for uniforms (approximately \$100) and umpire fees which will be divided by the number of players on the team. Umpires earn \$35 per game 10U and \$70 per game 12U and it is a 10-game season. (If the team makes the finals there will be additional games)
- Tournament play is at the discretion of the Recreation Department with input from the coaching staff and is an additional fee.
- **Try outs will be held at Summer Road Park on July 22nd from 6:00-7:45pm.** (Rain date TBA if needed)
- This is a try out for the Fall '26 and Spring/Summer '27 team. If you are unable to attend try outs but would like to be considered for one of the teams, please reach out to the Recreation Department at Rec@readington.gov.

There is no fee for tryouts, but pre-registration is required.

Once the teams are selected, players will be notified, and player registration will open. The registration fee for the 2026 fall season is \$155.00. Fees for uniforms, refs, and tournaments for the fall season are not included in the registration fee.

Moving forward teams will have Winter workouts once a week in January/February 2027 held in Readington schools. Spring Season will begin with pre-season indoor practices in March, followed by the Spring/Summer Parkway League plus some tournaments. These activities will incur an additional registration fee.

The Spring season is a separate registration fee, but players do not need to tryout again or purchase a uniform (unless theirs does not fit anymore).
